Introduction

A safe and successful warehouse operation is one that is efficient and orderly. The warehouse employee is necessary in ensuring that merchandise are circulated during the facility in a timely and efficient method. Due to the numerous activities involved within warehouse operations, staff in warehouse environment might be at greater risk for accidents than people who work in areas with more limited activities. Thus, companies place a top priority on warehouse safety.

Knowledge of potential warehouse dangers is important to avoiding accidents. Always be alert to potential dangers and ways to lessen risks. Do whatever is necessary to prevent accidents.

General Hazards

Common kinds of hazard in a warehouse environment are slips, trips and falls. These accidents are normally caused when staff lose their balance or stumble over an item that has not been put away correctly. Removing or placing stuff from storage can result in a slip or fumble, possibly leading to both worker and item to fall. The potential for slips, trips and falls is increased when workers are moving materials on various kinds of floor surfaces and on different levels. One more common hazard is getting hit by falling stuff. This is usually caused by failure to properly stack objects on shelves and other surfaces. Back injuries due to incorrect lifting methods are one more common danger.

Warehouse machines carries inherent hazards. Accidents or injuries could be caused by hand trucks, forklift trucks and conveyors if they are not operated right. Warehouse tools, like for example skids, pallets, cutting and strapping tools, should be utilized carefully during loading, packing and unpacking.

Materials that are hazardous, combustible or flammable present another type of workplace danger while being stored in a warehouse. Employees have to know how to take steps to protect themselves from health hazards while working around hazardous materials.
