Aerial Lift Training Tolleson - An aerial work platform is a mechanical access platform. This machinery provides access to otherwise not accessible areas for people or equipment. Also called an aerial device or elevating work platform, the machinery is often utilized to be able to access high areas. Maintenance and construction employees normally should make use of aerial work platforms on the job. They are used by firefighters for emergency access.

Intended for temporary use, aerial work platforms are distinguished from elevators, which provide permanent access to high areas. An aerial work platform is designed to be operated by one person, and can lift weights of not more than one ton. Several kinds have load limits which are higher. There are different kinds of aerial work platforms; for instance, there is a "cherry picker" and a "scissor lift".

Some aerial work platforms are available outfitted with compressed air connectors for power tools or electrical outlets. For specialist tasks, like for example lifting frames for window glass, an aerial work platform can come together with special tools.

People who want to operate an aerial lift device have to undergo training. Normally, the members of a Health & Safety Committee and their representatives are responsible for the inspection of every machine and work areas and are also required to go through training. Trainees will become familiar with aerial lifting device operation. They would also know the regulations that apply to safely utilizing these machinery. Regulations differ from province to province, and in worksites which are federally regulated.

Workers who work near or are required to be lifted by an aerial lifting machinery has to know all the potential hazards. An Aerial Lift Training Video can be shown in a general safety session to educate all of the staff who work near them or are lifted by them.

Nearly all Aerial Lift Training Program will consist of modules which are focused on the following areas: hazard Identification; Aerial Lift Devices and Operating Controls; Pre Operational Checks for Aerial Lift Devices; and Platform Positioning & Park Positioning. The program is intended to train workers on safely using self-propelled, boom supported elevated work platform and self-propelled, elevated work platform. A certificate would be provided to workers who complete the program, signed by an individual qualified to be able to confirm successfully completing a hands-on practical exam.
