Order Picker License Tolleson - Order preparation operation or likewise called order picking as it is more normally known is a method used in warehouse operations and comprises personnel known as order pickers. The order picker's duty is to collect and take articles in certain quantities so as to accomplish the client's orders before shipment. Order picking is a basic warehousing process. The effectiveness in which this particular task is done can be directly related to a supply chain's productivity. Therefore, order picking is amongst the most controlled logistic processes. Order picking falls within the category of the warehouse management system.

There are specific kinds of order picking which consist of: wave picking method, pick to box method, picker to part method or piece picking, zone picking method and sorting systems method.

The pick to box method involves the order picker only filling the boxes with item which are from their specific station. The box then moves on to other locations to until the order is done. In this particular technique, there is no movement of the order picker staff. In the wave picking method, the order pickers move around to collect the required products for some orders. The picker to part method or piece picking is similar where the order pickers or picker move to be able to gather the items required but for one order only.

In the sorting systems method, there is no movement of the order picking staff. Instead, the things are delivered to him or her via an automated system like a conveyor system or an automatic storage. In the zone picking method, each and every order picker is assigned to one specific zone. They are responsible for only realizing order picking in this specified zone.
