Theory Programs

The theory topics consist of: Safety fundamentals for crane operators; introduction to crane certification process; crane operation knowledge; rigging knowledge; load chart knowledge; crane rigging charts; crane service and maintenance and crane set-up and pre-trip inspections.

Practical Programs

The practical training section of the crane training school emphasizes hands-on learning. This portion of the course focuses on the identification and terminology of crane components. People training will have the chance to perform skills needed for crane operating, signaling and rigging.

Practical course topics: Identify crane components and functions; Learn crane terms; identify rigging and wire ropes; use remote control; identify regulations and documents for wire rope and rigging; pre-use inspection on crane; carry out rigging techniques; use radio and hand signals; and perform proper lifting and lowering of loads.
