Lessons consist of the placement of the chock blocks and trailer tires, the arrangement of pallets in order to spread out the load properly, and inspections required prior to driving into a trailer at a dock location. Courses also comprise Material Safety Data Sheet (or MSDS) training. Although not directly related to the use of a lift truck, MSDS training is vital in the event that an operator damages a container containing toxic materials, or notices a leaking container. MSDS sheets list the products, their effects on individuals and right ways of handling spills.
